WOODSTOCK, Nov. 12.—The annual meeting of the Ontario Ladies' Basketball Association was held here Saturday. It was the first annual meeting and considerable business was transacted. The reports showed the league in good standing. Last year London and Stratford, Toronto and Hamilton teams composed the league, but this year, in respect to have about fifteen teams lined up to be added into the divisions, Eastern, Western and Central.
