LIGHTKEEPER RESIGNS

Thomas Paterson Will Leave Post Long Head at Cape Beale on Island Coast

Thomas Paterson, who for many years has had charge of the light-house at Cape Beale, and who, with his wife, Mrs. Minnie Paterson, has done so much in aid of shipwrecked mariners and to save life, has tendered his resignation as lightkeeper. Mrs. Paterson's trip over the sodden trail to send the Quads, Friday night. The mains are to be of wooden pipe, wire wound, 8 inches and 6 inches in diameter. They are to withstand a hydrostatic pressure of a 300 foot head to the square inch. The pipes are to be laid eighteen inches below the surface and are to be guaranteed for five years. The pipe line road is to be ten feet wide and the pipe will be 14,000 feet in length.
