YUSEZ OV FONETICS

Fonetis iz ðe saiens ov spritch saundz and art ov proninsiesion; in its waidest sens ðe "saiens ov vois," diling not ònli wið artikyulet bít olso wið inartikyulet saundz ov animalz az wel az men. ðe term, oridjinali sinonimos, "fonoloji," iz nau restrikted tu ðe histori and thori ov saund-chenjez. Its mōst obvios practical aplicesion iz tu acwizision ov foren langwejez. Its aplicesionz tu netiv-langwej stidi ar not les important: ònli bai its help iz it possibl tu dil efektivli wið vulgarizmz and provinsializmz ov proninsiesion, and tu seciur yuniformiti ov spritch; ònli on a fonetic basis can ðe def-dim bī tot artikyulet spritch. From a mōr theoretic viu-point fonetics iz ðe saiens ov lingwistic obzervesion: wiðaut fonetic trening dialectologists and missionariz confrinited wið a langwej hiðertu inritn can niðer obzerv fulli nor record akyuratli ðe fenomena wið hwitch ðe hav tu dil. Ðiz investigesionz hav gretli waidend ðe scōp ov ðe saiens ov langwej. Modern filolojists no longer despaiz colökial and illiterat formz ov spritch. On ðe contrari ðe consider ðat in ðem ðe laif and grōth ov langwej iz sín mōr circli ðan in ded literari langwejez on huz stadi comparativ filoloji woz ecsclusivli bilt at ferst. Not til filolojists began tu ask hwot wer ðe rial faktz underlaiing ðe comparison ov ritn werdz in Sanscrit, Grīk, Latin and iðer Indo-Yuropian langwejez embodid in sitsh jeneralizesionz az Grim'z Lo, ðat "leter saiens" developt intu "saund-saiens" (fonoloji). ðe raiz and dece ov infleksionz and ðe development ov grammatic formz jeneraliz ar, from ðe formal viu-point, menli fonetic problemz; and fonetics enterz mōr or les intu evri department ov historic and comparativ gramar.—*Encyclopedia Britan.*, 11th ed., vol. xxi, p. 458,

instrumental methodz hav supersided natyural wnz as Arabic supersided Roman niumeralz. Ðis asampsion haz had dizastros rezults. It can not bī tū often reptited ðat instrumental fonetics iz, striktli spiking, not fonetics at ol. It iz ònli a help; it ònli siplaiz matrial yusles til tested and accepted from ðe lingwistic fonetisian'z viu-point. ðe fainal arbiter in ol fonetic cwestionz iz ðe trend ir ov a praktical fonetisian: difrensez not persivd mist—at list me—bī ignord; hwot contradicts ðe trend ir can not bī accepted.—*Ency.
