A QUESTION.

The pertinent question, which is so often asked, " How is it that agency subscribers, who manage their business so badly, spend at the rate of from \$5,000 to \$20,000 yearly of their creditors' or bank shareholders' money (when they are hopelessly insolvent), manage to get compromises of from 10c to 50c in the dollar?" The reason is that Canadian creditors are often Mercantile Agency subscribers themselves-members of the same ring as the insolvent, and therefore generally tarred with the same brush, and have likely more than once obtained a compromise themselves. They dare not refuse to sign for a compromise, for fear of the insolvent exposing some of their financial trickery.
