EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to refer to your Note No. 124 of June 29, 1973 proposing that the conditions set forth in it and the Annex thereto, which accord with the understandings reached between representatives of our two Governments, should govern the use of facilities at the Goose Bay Airport by the United States after June 30, 1973.

I am pleased to inform you that my Government concurs in the proposal set forth in your Note. My Government further agrees that your Note, together with its Annex, and this reply, which is authentic in English and French, shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on July 1, 1973, and remain in effect until June 30, 1976.
