A spokesman for Barshefsky said Washington was disappointed in the Canadian government's position.

The dairy dispute is the first to come before a panel since U.S. President Bill Clinton and Marchi publicly appealed last spring for more openness in world trade talks, said Jay Ziegler, a spokesman for Barshefsky.
