CANADA-BULGARIA TRADE AGREEMENT EXTENDED

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Mitchell Sharp, and the Ambassador to Canada of the People's Republic of Bulgaria, His Excellency Kiril Chterev, today exchanged instruments of ratification of the Protocol signed on April 26, 1967, extending the 1963 Canada-Bulgaria Trade Agreement for another three years.

The Protocol provides for the continued extension of most-favoured-nation treatment by both countries to the goods of the other, and includes a Bulgarian undertaking to purchase 200,000 tons of Canadian wheat during the three-year period.
