APPOINTMENT OF MR. CLAUDE JULIEN TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE CANADIAN INSTITUTE FOR INTERNATIONAL PEACE AND SECURITY

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announced today the appointment of Mr. Claude Julien to the seventeen-member Board of Directors of the Canadian Institute for International Peace and Security (CIIPS). The appointment is for a three-year term.

Mr. Julien, who resides in Paris, France, is currently Editor and Director of Le Monde Diplomatique and President of the Centre d'études et de recherches sur l'Amérique latine (CETRAL). He has pursued an extensive career in journalism, primarily with Le Monde and Le Monde Diplomatique. He is the author of nine books which deal largely with international affairs and politics, including Le Canada, dernière chance de l'Europe (1965).

Mr. Julien's appointment was made following consultations with the Leader of the Official Opposition and the Leader of the New Democratic Party in accordance with the CIIPS Act (Bill C-32).

CIIPS was formally established on August 15, 1984, with the support of all parties. It reports annually to Parliament. The purpose of the Institute is to increase knowledge and understanding of issues related to international peace and security from a Canadian perspective, with particular emphasis on arms control, disarmament, defence and conflict resolution.
