Mr. McCleave, from the Standing Committee on Miscellaneous Private Bills, presented the Tenth Report of the said Committee, which is as follows:

Your Committee has considered Bill No. SD-199, An Act for the relief of William Harrison Terry, and has agreed to report the preamble thereof not proven on the grounds that they are not satisfied that adultery on the part of the respondent has been proven.
