4. That the Corporation shall, upon any advances being made, deposit with the Minister of Finance debentures of the Corporation equal in par value to the advance so made, repayable within twenty-five years from the date of issue, and bearing interest payable half-yearly at the rate of five per centum per annum.

5. That the principal and interest of any sums advanced under any Act founded on these Resolutions shall be payable by the Corporation out of all its property, assets, tolls, rates, dues, penalties and other sources of revenue and income whatsoever, and shall rank as a charge thereon and have precedence in regard to payment next after the payments provided for in Section 27 of Chapter 54 of the Statutes of 1913.

Mr. L. J. LADNER (Vancouver South): I would suggest that the hon. minister allow this resolution to stand until Monday. The hon. member for Vancouver Centre (Mr. Stevens), who is well informed on this important matter, desires to discuss it, and there are features of it which I think it would be of interest to the House and to the country to have him deal with.

Mr. LAPOINTE: I am quite willing to accede to the request of my hon. friend.

Mr. SPEAKER: Next sitting. Resolution stands.

Right Hon. W. L. MACKENZIE KING (Prime Minister): As it is a few minutes to six o'clock, Mr. Speaker, I move that the House do now adjourn. We rather expected to take up and dispose of the several government notices of motion on the order paper, but as the last resolution has been postponed, the government orders had better stand over
