

*Supply*

to the attention of the House already once today a memorandum to the Minister from one Maureen Lovies which indicates that in fact the million dollars from the federal Government was laundered through Nova Scotia. After looking at the documents, we find, from the document of January 15, in the words "You will recall", a clear indication that the Minister of Finance knew well before January 15. In my final minute let me just say to those Members opposite who have said that the reputation of the House is at stake, that they are right. That is what is at stake here. What is at stake is parliamentary democracy. If that kind of behaviour, a clear violation of these guidelines, is to be permitted and sanctioned by the vote of a bunch of sheep on the backbenches of the Liberal Party, then this House has lost its right to sit. We have no purpose in being here if that kind of behaviour is to be sanctioned.
