- 3. The same applies to this case, except the it is not sworn to.
- 4. Declaration very doubtful, and incomplete
- 5. This case should certainly not have been liquidated by us, and constitutes a very serious 'irregularity' in regard to the sworn Declaration, as there were ample funds of deceased.
- The account for this case ante-dates the government grant by a year and should certainly not have been liquidated by us.
