The Griper was a gun brig of one hundred and eighty tons, which had been considerably strengthened and raised upon, to accompany Captain Parry on his first voyage, under the command of Lieutenant now Captain Liddon. Every comfort, in food and other necessities, was most liberally provided for us, and Sylvester's stove was fitted in the hold, in the same manner as in Captain Parry's vessels.
