Mr. Wintemburg also furnishes sketch and data of another long-siemmed, white-stone, lizard pipe from the shore of Lake Baptiste, Herschell Township, Hastings County, Ontario, now in the Victoria Memorial Museum, Ottawa.

"Much of the polished surface is scaled off. The legs are still plain on the side shown in the outline sketch. The projection intended for ears still recognizable, but the head otherwise badly weathered. Length, 51% inches. Height, 33% inches. Diameter of bowl, about 11% inches.
