BRUNSWICK, Germany, May 23.— Holding in contempt the pretensions of the professional nurses and ignoring their advice, the Duchess of Brunswick has taken practically the whole care of her infant son, who was nine weeks old last Wednesday. At times the nurses have appealed to the attending physician, who merely remarked that an allowance much be made in the case of the first baby. All her waking hours the duchess passes in sight of her treasure, who some day may be seated as king on the restor-

ed throne of Hanover.

The babe's name is Ernest Augustus George William Christian Ludwig Francis Joseph Nicholas, for his father, and the Monarchs of England, Germany, Denmark, Bavaria. Austria and Russia all those sovereigns being his godfathers.

The christening on May 9 was the occasion of a grand reconciliation between the father, Prince Ernest, Duke of Brunswick, and the German crown prince who quarreled over the Duke's

accession.

Cracked Wheat Bread

Cracked Wheat Bread

T last the recipe for cracked wheat bread, requested long ago by a reader of this column, has been sent in by a friend of Efficient Housekeeping in New Brunswick.

In her letter this lady says that the original recipe was used by a neighbor who was one of the early settlers in the community, and that the method described has been used for five interestative generations in this family.

"Cracked wheat bread: Crush the wheat as fine as you can with a pestle and steam it thirty minutes. To every fair pints of wheat one-half pint of moist yeast and a tablespoon of salt. But enough water in to make a sponge. Let this rise as with ordinary bread knead but little. Some flour may be added to make a stiff dough, but the wheat swells in rising and it is not often needed. The loaf is richer and cuts more smoothly if a little melted butter is added to the sponge."

Under the name of "whole wheat" or crushed wheat there is sold in our markets a flour used for making whole wheat and so called health bread, but it is very different from the entire wheat crushed with mortar and pestle by frontier women. The bread made from the latter is moist, sweet and tender and probably has all the wholesome qualities that so endear the health bread to persons living on special diets.

The barley loaf and oats bread, so loved by Social is not so fine as cracked wheat bread; indeed, from all times thentimiosyes have been the true staff of life. The grain of wheat contains all that is necessary to support life—starch, gluten, sugar, salts, potath, sode, hime, phosphoric acid, magnesia and carbon and nitrogen.

When crushed by hand the bran, or outer covering of the grain, is retained, and so bread made from it is much more nourishing than when made from wheat flour that has been bolted until only the fine white flour-dist results.
