

BY-LAWS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STEPHEN.

BY-LAW NO. X, FOR 1882.

*By-Law to prevent Damage to Highways and Bridges in the
Municipality.*

Whereas it is necessary to pass a By-law to prevent injury to the public roads and bridges in this township, be it therefore enacted by the municipal council of the township of Stephen, that it shall not be lawful for any person to take from any ground set apart for the purpose of a highway, or originally surveyed as such and belonging to this municipality, any gravel, stone, sand, timber or other material, except by the authority of this council; and any person taking any such material from any road allowance in this municipality shall be liable to a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than twenty over and above the value of the property taken.

Furthermore, be it likewise enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall not be lawful for any person to place any fence, tree, or other obstruction on any road, highway, culvert or bridge in this township shall be liable to a fine of not less than one dollar nor more than twenty dollars, and such person shall likewise be liable to any loss or damage which any person or persons or this municipality may sustain through the placing of such obstructions on any highway, culvert or bridge in this township.
