**DATES FOR REGISTRATION.**

May 7, 8, 9, 10 and 14 Fixed by the Board Yesterday.

The Board of Registration yesterday fixed May 7, 8, 9 and 10 as the dates for registering those entitled to vote in the provincial elections who are not on the lists. May 14 was named as a supplementary date for those who are unable to present themselves on the previous days. A court of appeal will also be held on Friday, May 10, when Judge McDougall will decide the validity of the claims of those who find it impossible to convince the registrars of their right to register.

Twenty-five registration booths are to be established in localities as determined by Judge McDougall within the next few days.

**Went to New Mexico.**

George McConnell Left His Business Affairs Muddled.

George McConnell, who formerly carried on a wholesale liquor business in Leader-lane, under the firm name of George McConnell & Co., is being sought by Sheriff Harris, who wants him to appear for examination as a judgment debtor. It is understood that McConnell has gone to New Mexico, leaving his business affairs in a very unsatisfactory state.

McConnell gave up the business on March 1, and an examination of his books showed liabilities of \$3000 and assets of \$400, made up of book debts, but no stock. A few of the creditors were paid at the rate of 25 to 50 cents on the dollar, while other claims were ignored. George McConnell, of Montreal, is a creditor to the extent of \$807. Of this amount, notes totalling \$225 were due on April 1, and five days later Messrs. Dewar, Young & Maw, acting for Percival, secured a speedy judgment against McConnell. The next move was to get the defendant to appear for examination, but, as stated above, he cannot be found.

**Resolution of Condolence.**

The Council placed on record its sympathies for the late Mr. J. H. Bousfield, who died on the 19th inst., and the grateful appreciation of the public-spirited labors of Mr. Bousfield through his active life. A resolution, moved by Ald. McMurrich, and seconded by Ald. Frame, was passed, and a copy of it, suitably engrossed, will be presented to the family of the deceased.

**Tackled the Order Paper.**

The grit of motions which have been lying motionless on the order paper for weeks, and some for months, got an innings. Ald. Fleming was about to move to take up the order paper when the Mayor called a special meeting to dispose of them.

**Power From Niagara.**

The Engineer will also be asked to report on the motion of Ald. Graham that the proper officers communicate with the Niagara Power Company with a view of getting full information regarding the terms, etc., upon which the Niagara Power Company is willing to supply electric energy to manufacturers and others in this city.

**One Cent Postage.**

A motion of Ald. Burns to again petition the government to reduce the postal rate on drop letters from Toronto to one cent was carried. The Mayor said that he would support the motion of Ald. Burns as to what is necessary to put the water front in a proper and creditable condition, with an estimate of the cost to extend all streets out to Lake-street, and the construction of Lake-street be at once proceeded with in order to furnish a dumping ground for street refuse.

**Ald. Urquhart's Idea.**

Ald. Urquhart's motion that a special committee be appointed to consider the reorganization of the Works Department was referred to the Council by the motion of Ald. Frame.

**Government Ownership.**

The motion of Ald. Frame that a petition be presented to the Dominion Parliament praying that such legislation be passed as will enable the government of Canada to take over and thereafter operate the telephone and telegraph systems in Canada, except so much thereof as pertains to railway companies' private business, was referred to the Council by the motion of Ald. Frame.

**Special Meeting for Gas.**

The Council decided to hold a special meeting next Monday night to discuss the question of gas, as proposed by Ald. Sheppard's motion to have the plant and buildings renewed at a cost of \$10,000.

**Favor Afternoon Meetings.**

There was a lot of amusement over Ald. Burns' motion that the Council in a bill to amend the by-law relating to the proceedings of the Council should hereinafter be held at 7 o'clock instead of 8. The proposal was turned down on the following division:

Yeas (4): Ald. Burns, Spence, Richardson, Bell, Fleming, Urquhart.

Nays (11): Ald. Lamb, W. T. Stewart, Sheppard, Hubbard, Frame, Curry, A. Stewart, Hall, Crane, Graham, Chisholm.

John Campbell wrote on behalf of himself and other working men endorsing the motion of Ald. Burns, and the Council in the evening instead of in the afternoon. A similar communication was sent from Joseph Campbell at an early stage of the meeting.

**Large Party for Europe.**

An unusually large party left on the Canadian Pacific Railway last evening for Boston, en route for Europe. The party was composed of a number of Toronto's most prominent citizens, both socially and professionally, who are sailing from Boston this week by the Dominion and Cunard Line steamers, which have become so popular. Two Pullmans were at the disposal of the party, who were in charge of Mr. A. F. Webster, Superintendent of the Dominion Steamship Lines.

**What Robin May Do.**

Winnipeg, April 21.—It is said that the Robin government intends to make an attempt to conclude the big minority which voted for the Liquor Act by introducing legislation restricting liquor traffic in Manitoba.

**Pope is Assured.**

Rome, April 21.—The Pope has been personally assured, thru the English bishops now in Rome, that there is a good prospect of peace in South Africa on the basis of Kitchener's terms of 1901.
