

FROM ALL QUARTERS HOSTILITY IS ARISING AGAINST BORDENISM

Lindsay Crawford Tells the Liberal Club How Manufacturers, Farmers and War Veterans Have Nothing But Condemnation for Union Regime.

In a meeting last night that was full of enthusiasm, Lindsay Crawford, editor of the Statesman, inaugurated the series of lectures at the Liberal Club which will continue this winter.

Mr. Crawford, who is one of the outstanding figures in Liberalism today, was vociferously applauded as he addressed the audience in Hyman Hall.

"Western Liberals have not organized a day too soon," said Mr. Crawford, "if Liberalism is to survive in Ontario it must no longer be controlled by a little coterie in the city of Toronto."

Referring to the entry of women into politics, the speaker said that it was a mistake to regard women as a new force in politics, and that they were taking a serious interest in public affairs, and would insist on an intelligent discussion of public questions.

The future of the education and organization of public opinion. This was the keynote of the speech from its most elementary functions. That abandonment was doubly lamentable because it had been associated in some cases with filthy lucre.

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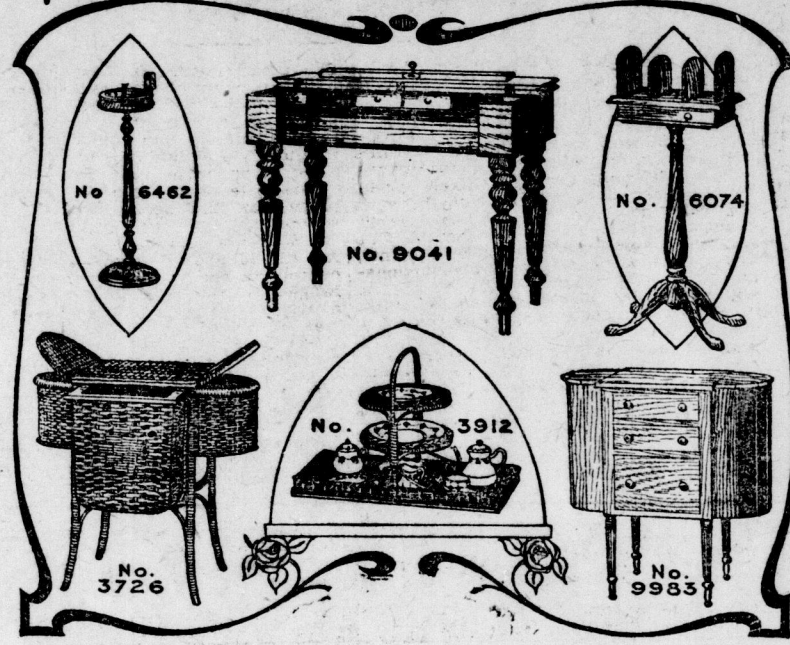
