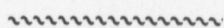




ABSTRACT OF

Minutes of Congregational Meeting.



TORONTO, January 18, 1888.

The thirty-fourth annual meeting of the congregation was held this evening, according to intimation from the pulpit on the two preceding Sabbaths.

The meeting was opened with devotional exercises, conducted by Rev. Dr. Kellogg, who also reviewed at some length the steady growth of the church, both in additions to its membership and the increase in the amounts contributed for the various Schemes of the Church.

Mr. Henry W. Darling was then called to the Chair, and Mr. W. E. Long appointed Secretary of the meeting.

The minutes of last congregational meeting were read and confirmed. The Secretary then read the Managers' Report and also the Treasurer's Statement.

It was moved by Mr. R. Kilgour, seconded by Mr. Hugh Millar, "That the Report and Treasurer's Statement be received and adopted, and that the thanks of the congregation are due and are hereby tendered to the Managers, and especially to the Treasurer, for the manner in which they have discharged their duties."
