Chinese silk manufacturers are realizing that modern methods must be adopted if they are to obtain western trade, and they have made a great innovation in opening a mail order and export department in Shanghai, said a Chinese merchant in New York. The silks are manufactured in Hang-Show and Suichow, and heretofore, even with those firms having purchasing agents in Shanghai, the agent was obliged to give his orders. Now he goes to the Shanghai headquarters, where he can comfortably talk business. This innovation will make several weeks' difference in time in the delivery of the goods, whether the order is given personally or sent by mail. Quebec, May 23.—Instructions have been received by Captain T. M. Street of the United States army, of the war department at Washington, asking him to proceed at the end of the month with four river transport boats, which were icebound here all winter, to New York via the Gulf. Captain Street said that the boats are unseaworthy and that after they were built last year they were almost wrecked in a storm on Lake Erie. Despite his protest, however, the orders stand, and in signifying his willingness to carry them out he wrote his superior, "We who are about to die, salute thee."
