

Tomatoes need a certain amount of attention just at present. Remember that they figure as one of the most valuable solad crops and they are especially good when canned.

They should be kept well staked up, and this is particularly desirable if the earth around them is wet or heavy. Otherwise the tomatoes are apt to lie on the ground and rot. In some of the plants the shoots should be reduced to one leader so as to give early fruit. They get a better chance to ripen if the foliage is kept well pruned for then the sun and air can get at the tomatoes and hasten their development.

The same bug that ravages the potato plant often finds its way to the tomatoe plant and works havoc there. Last year this pest was particularly active and it is quite time to be on the look out for it now. Most people think that if the bugs are taken off, all is well. This is a mistake. Much more dangerous than the well-grown potato bugs are the orange-colored egg masses which cling to the leaves on the under side. Hundreds of small bugs are hatched from these clusters. Life should be promptly crushed out of the egg masses whenever they are discovered.


