"On Tuesday, 25 Mar 41, I was on duty at the 1 Cdn Div Field Punishment Camp, Nutfield, Surrey, from 1400 hours to 1600 hours. At approximately 1557 hours, a Soldier Under Sentence in # 2 Hut asked permission from me to go to the Latrine. I gave him this permission and let him go unattended as I was alone on duty and it was necessary for me to watch #cI Hut ask there were Soldiers under sentence in it and the door had to be left open as some Engineers were working on the Hut. At 1600 hours, my relief, L/Cpl. Hayes relieved me and I told him after handing over the keys, that I had allowed one man to go to the Latrine unattended. I then went off duty."

Q. Do you recognize the Accused as being the Soldier Under Sentence whom you allowed to go to the Latrine?

A. "Yes sir, I do."

Q. Did you know at the time that the Accused was awaiting Court Martial?

A. "No sir, I did not."
