Losses Have Been Heavy, but Allies Have Inflicted Heavier, and Have Gained More than Million ENEMY RECEIVES A Men in Consequence of German Offensive -Moral Effects of Attack All on Entente Side.

London, April 23.-More than one million soldiers in addition to those who would otherwise be in the field against Germany, have been gained by the Allies in consequence of the German offensive, Winston Spencer Churchill, Minister of Munitions, said today in an address to the American labor delegation which is visiting England.

"So far as moral effects are concerned," he said , "all that the Germans have achieved by the battle has been an increase in the closer consolidation of the forces fighting against them. By their attack they have called into the field against them in this campaign alone more than one million soldiers additional to those who would otherwise have been there.
