ANNO VICESIMO

fons fhall prefume to exercife the profeffion of a Carter, for hire, within the town or fuburbs of Quebec, after the publication hereof without obtaining a certificat from the Clerk of the Peace specifying the number of his cart or carriage and the time of his being registered as fuch; And the faid number shall be painted (with red paint) on his cart or carriage, and the faid Clerk of the Peace is hereby impowered to grant fuch certificate on due application and to keep a book wherein he is to infert the carter's name, and the time of entry and the number he is to have on his cart or carriage, to the end that the perfons injured may the more eafily obtain redrefs.

That from and after the publication hereof, no perfon or perfons fhall on any pretence whatfoever, gallop of ride at full fpeed on horfeback or in any carriage, or having the charge of any horfe or horfes in any loaded cart, truck or fled, fhall ride on fuch horfe or horfes or remain placed in or upon any part of fuch cart, truck or fled, within any of the ftreets or high-ways in or adjacent to the town or fuburbs of Quebec; And that no fuch driver or drivers fhall omit during fuch time to lead fuch horfe or horfes by the reins, nor fhall drive fuch horfe or horfes fafter than a foot pace, and that no owner or owners of any trucks, carts or fleds fhall employ young boys to drive the fame but fuch perfon or perfons as are capable to load and unload their refpective carriage or carriages.

All drivers of carts, trucks, fleds or other carriages, when unemployed, are hereby ordered and required to repair to the Market-places in the Upper or Lower-town and to remain there 'till they are engaged to work, and fo foon as they are engaged they fhall immediately depart and they fhall not plead a prior engagement but muft go with the first perfor who demands them.

And it is declared and enacted by the Ordinance aforefaid, that any carter who shall, after the publication of the foregoing table or regulation, afk or receive a higher price than is thereby allowed, or shall refuse to work and be employed at the price specified in such rate or shall disobey any of the regulations made by the Commissioners of the Peace, shall for every offence forfeit the sum of twenty shillings to be recovered if fued for within fifteen days by information before any one Commissioner of the Peace who shall hear and determine such information in a summary manner and upon the oath of one credible witnels, such penalty together with the costs of fuing for the same to be levied by a warrant to seize and fell the goods of the offender, one half of such penalty shall belong to the King's Majesty and the other to the person who shall fue for the fame.
