An Act to enable Trustees of Common Schools in Upper Canada to sell School Houses or School Sites, when no longer required.

HEREAS it is expedient to make further provision for the main- Preamble. tenance of Common Schools in the several villages, towns, townships, and counties of Upper Canada: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I.
