

An Act to enable Trustees of Common Schools in Upper Canada to sell School Houses or School Sites, when no longer required.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make further provision for the main- Preamble.
 tenance of Common Schools in the several villages, towns, town-
 ships, and counties of Upper Canada; Therefore Her Majesty, &c.,
 enacts as follows:

- 5 I. Any school site or school-house in any school section or union of School sites or
