BILL.

An Act to extend the jurisdiction of Division Courts in Upper Canada, and otherwise to amend the Law relative to the said Courts.

HEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act passed Preamble. in the Session held in the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to 13 & 14 Vict. "amend and consolidate the several Acts now in force, regu- c. 53. 5 "lating the practice of Division Courts in Upper Canada, "and to extend the jurisdiction thereof," by further extending the jurisdiction of the said Courts: Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That from and after the passing of this Act, the Judge of Jurisdiction 10 every Division Court shall have power, jurisdiction and of the Division authority to hold plea of all claims and demands what- Courts ever, for or against any person or persons, bodies corpo-extended. rate or otherwise, of debt, account, or breach of contract or covenant or money demand, whether payable in 15 money or otherwise, where the amount or balance claimed shall not exceed the sum of fifty pounds, and where such amount or balance claimed shall have first been ascertained by the verbal acknowledgment or signature of the defendant or defendants.

II. And be it enacted, That it shall not be lawful for Delay the Judge of any Division Court to order Execution to allowed for execution issue against the goods or chattels of any party for a sum for any sum exceeding ten pounds, in a less period than three months over £10. after the service of the original Summons in the case,

25 unless the party in whose favor such judgment has been Exception. obtained, shall prove to the satisfaction of the Judge, either by his own oath or that of some other credible person, that he or she will be in danger of losing the said debt if such delay be granted, in which case it shall be 30 lawful for the said Judge, in his discretion, either to order execution to be issued at any period within the three

months aforesaid, or to order the party against whom the judgment has been obtained to give security for the pay-

ment of the said judgment and costs at the expiration of 35 the said period of three months.

III. And be it enacted, That all suits brought under Act cited in the enlarged jurisdiction conferred by this Act, shall in the Preamble extended to all respects be subject to the provisions of the Act cited cases under in the preamble to this Act, except in so far only as the this Act. 40 same may be inconsistent with those of this Act, and that no greater costs shall in any case be allowed in suits for sums over twenty-five pounds than are now chargeable by law on suits for sums of twenty-five pounds under the authority of said Act.
