being required, and any servant, agent or other officer who may detect the offender in the act of committing any of the said offences, may arrest him and take him before any such Magistrate or Justice of the Peace, 5 who upon conviction may commit the offender to the Common Gaol of the District, for a period not exceeding thirty days in default of payment of the penalty: Provided always, that over and above the said penalties the 10 said association may recover the damages sustained.

The Association may remove monuments erected without their authority.

XXIV. And be it enacted, That the said Association may take down and remove any gravestone, monument, tablet, or monumental inscription which shall have been placed within the Cemetery without their authority.

A public Act.

XXV. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be a Public Act, and as such shall be judicially noticed by all Courts, Judges, Ma-20 gistrates, Justices of the Peace and others whom it may concern, without being specially pleaded or proved.
