Sir

I arrived here the night before last from Kamuch and am getting ready to proceed to the Carlton Agency to release the boundaries of the Indian Reserves in that district as per your instructions

I think it would be desirable to purchase my two (2) team (horses) etc etc for transport purposes as I find it will come very light to have teams for this purpose and then not always satisfactory

I have at present ten hundred dollars (\$600) on hand from the advance of twenty five hundred dollars (\$2500) before leaving Ottawa

I would ask that the sum of ten hundred dollars (\$1000) be wired to my credit Imperial Bank Ltd (James Albert Lusk)

I attach statement of expenditure
