I have been for some time in expec-
tation of hearing further from you on the subject of
my letter of the 8th December, which you acknowledged on
the 19th of that month, - promising at the same time
that you would endeavour to make yourself Master of all
the particulars of the transaction to which it refers, and
that you would report upon the same.

The subject being one, which I presume
has undergone ample discussion in the neighbourhood,
and the particulars such as cannot be unknown to the
Officers of the Department, I am a good deal disappointed
at the time you have allowed to elapse without enabling
me to lay before The Commander of The Forces, The in-
formation His Lordship has called for, and which you
were required by my letter of the 8th December to submit
in a detailed report. - Whatever cause may have led to
a neglect of these Instructions, I have now to desire that
you will immediately attend to them, and forward the
Information which you can have had no difficulty in
collecting.
