PRESS COLLUNIQUÉ.

The Principal Delegates held their fifteenth meeting at 11 o'clock this morning in the Cabinet Room at No. 10 Downing Street, Mr. Chamberlain in the Chair.

A memorandum from His Royal Highness the Duke of Gloucester, President of the Imperial War Graves Commission communicating a report on the work of the Commission, was considered and the Conference decided to place on record its warm appreciation of the work which had been accomplished and of the manner in which the Commission had discharged and were continuing to discharge the duties entrusted to them.

The Conference further considered the situation in the Pacific and the Far East and the meeting was adjourned until Wednesday, 9th June, 5 p.m.
