If the Church lives up to the promises of God in Christ Jesus it will be victorious. It is the duty of the Church to blaze the trail to that better day that lies ahead, and this can be done only by Faith in God.

How shall we foster this Faith in God? By communion with Him. By daily lifting the soul to God. By the study of His Word. By the doing of His will.

"If any man shall do my will he shall know of the doctrine."

So, Faith leads to Greater Faith.
