"I am H 5046 Sgt Primerger R. J.
7 Fd Bty RCA. Sgt Clarke woke me up and told me that we had been ordered by Sgt Neale to come up and relieve Bdr Corbett's gun crew. Previously I was on the gun when we had been put out of action.
