* Any opinion of the convening officer with respect to the composition of the Court (See Army Act, s. 48 (10) and Rules of Procedure 20 and 21) should be added here; thus, where a Court-Martial is ordered to assemble, composed exclusively of officers of the same regiment of cavalry, or the same brigade of artillery, or the same battalion of infantry, the following should be added:—

"In the opinion of the convening officer, other officers are not, having due regard to the public service, available," (or as the case may be).

† Add here, in the case of either a General or District Court-Martial where a captain is appointed president and the officer convening the court is not under the rank of field officer. "In the opinion of the convening officer a field officer is not, having due regard to the public service, available." Where it is necessary for an officer under the rank of captain to be appointed president of a District Court-Martial, add, "In the opinion of the convening officer a field officer or captain is not, having due regard to the public service, available."
