Sir,-

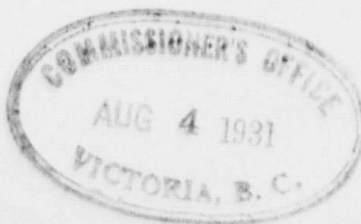
Commissioner Ditchburn has advised the Department on behalf of Willie Bob, an Indian of the Toquanna Band, that owing to the low market price of logs, it is somewhat of a hardship for him to have to pay the full royalty of \$2.00 per M F. B. M. on timber cut by him under permit, for sale.

In view of these circumstances, you are authorized to reduce this rate of royalty to \$1.00 per M, which amount should be sent to the Department for credit of Band Funds in the usual manner.
