2. The Cabinet, after discussion, noted the report by the Minister of Transport that the Arctic patrol vessel "C. D. Howe" would not be chartered to the Australian government for a projected Antarctic expedition.

Parliament; Calgary West by-election

- 3. The Prime Minister, referring to discussion at the meeting of October 13th, 1951, submitted a recommendation for the holding of a by-election on December 10th in the electoral district of Calgary West.
- 4. The Cabinet, after discussion, agreed that a by-election be held in the electoral district of Calgary West to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Mr. A. L. Smith; the writ for such by-election to be dated October 25th, 1951, and the day of polling to be December 10th, 1951; an Order in Council to be passed accordingly.

(Order in Council P.C. 5670, Oct. 25, 1951.)

- 5. The Secretary submitted certain draft measures.
- 6. The Cabinet, after discussion, approved the following measures:
 - (a) for introduction in the House of Commons:

bill entitled "The Old Age Security Act"; and bill to amend the Government Annuities Act; and,

(b) for introduction in the Senate in the first instance:

bill entitled "The Whaling Convention Act".
