Const. Barnes- 8782.  
Toronto ATC - That's Malton Airport, Toronto, and if you do get any reports, we would appreciate it if you would phone us immediately.  
Const. Barnes- Yes I will. What was the time you say, 2:30?  
Toronto ATC - Yes. He was in contact with Toronto radio. The last contact was at 117 and he had gas until 2:30. At that time he was lost in
