For the. last two and other offences he was pursued, convicted and sentenced. During the intervening time efforts have been made to locate Belt and determine his fate. The Commissioner of Mounted Police advised the department at Ottawa that in his opinion, Cashel had murdered Bat and thrown his body into the Rid River. This statement was verified in July, when a body was found in the river. There was a bullet wound in the corpse, which was identified as that of Belt. Cashel was brought to tri-l, when conclusive evidence as to his guilt was adduced. Now he will expiate his crime on the scaffold. The case of three Chinamen, convicted of the murder of a countryman in British to look for a fresh one, I presume-Columbia, was also before the Cabinet. The perplexing question was to determine which of the trio committed the murder, and the men were reprieved until the 18th inst., after which their sentence will be commuted to life imprison-






