SIR WALTER RALEIGH beheaded 1618, aged 66. He was one of those famous men of Devon who did so much for England in the 16th century. He was related to Humphrey Gilbert. He rapidly rose in favor in Elizabeth's reign but on the accession of James I. he fell into disgrace.

EDMUND HALLEY born 1656. English astronomer-royal from 1720 to 1742. He discovered what is known as Halley's comet.

JOHN KEATS born 1795. The great English poet who though dying at the early age of 25 produced a number of poems which in richness of imagination and beauty of thought are not excelled by anything in the language.

GEORGE MORLAND died 1804, aged 41. A painter whose pictures of English rural life were remarkable for their fidelity and breadth of treatment and are much valued.
