MATCHED PENNIES FOR \$1,000 A TOSS

Pittsburg Man Gambles Away One Million in a Year.

HAS THE RECORD FOR PLUNGING into the gambling houses of New York. Hostetter died in this city last August in a Park avenue sanitarium. Johnson denied today that the \$15,000 was entirely a gambling debt. In part he said it was borrowed money. Stubs in Hostetter's check book show that of the lost million \$20,000 had been paid to Johnson. The rest of the money went to Richard Canfield and John Daly, whose houses were young Hostetter's, frequently patronized. Richard Canfield had 1. O. U.s signed by Hostetter amounting to \$30,000 when the young man died. On the day after his death Canfield went to the home of the widow at 5 East Seventy-third street, and demanded payment.

Johnson's acquisition of nearly \$750,000 from a single throw within the space of a year makes Richard Canfield's winning of \$70,000 from young Reginald Vanderbilt insignificant. Indeed Hostetter's experience established a record in this country at least for high losses. Hostetter's checks poured in on Johnson so fast that he did not have time to collect them all before the young millionaire died unexpectedly from an attack of pneumonia. He was over \$500,000 to the good, but there still remained uncollected a promissory note of \$10,000 and checks for \$70,000, \$20,000 and \$15,000. Executors discovered that Johnson already had been paid over \$500,000 for gambling debts. Johnson insisted on payment, and also claim that the money was his. The dead millionaire's gambling habits aired in court his family instructed the executors to effect a compromise. This was done.

If Theodore Hostetter lost \$1,000,000, said Johnson, "I don't know anything about it. Young Hostetter was the most nervous man I ever saw, and you may say the luckiest as well. I became acquainted with him eight years ago and became his representative in sporting matters. He had all kinds of money and the instincts of a 'true blue' sport. I liked Ted's spirit and became his betting commissioner. He made a fortune in the stock market and in many of his sporting ventures. He matched pennies with Ted at the Waldorf-Astoria for \$1,000 a toss. In the last national election he won \$30,000 on McKinley. He made a number of calculations on the majorities and won every one of them.

Call Loans to Be Reduced.

Washington, Feb. 11.—Great Britain's protocol has been formally accepted by Mr. Bowen for Venezuela. The German and Italian conventions are still undergoing revision, but assurances are given in authoritative quarters that they eventually will be made to conform in all essential respects to that of the British ambassador. Owing to the illness of the British ambassador, Mr. Bowen called at the embassy today and personally signified his approval of the protocol.

Nothing But Some Minor Details Bars the Way to an Early Settlement.

London, Feb. 11.—It is announced in a dispatch to a news agency from St. Petersburg, that all the officers of the Russian army reserves have been notified to hold themselves in readiness to rejoin their regiment in 24 hours in the event of mobilization orders being issued. The measure, it is added, appears to be connected with fears of trouble in the Balkans.

PROVOKED OUTRAGES.
 London, Feb. 11.—The Sofia correspondent of the Times sends an account of recent events in the disturbed parts of Macedonia, collected by an investigator of unquestionable impartiality and accuracy, which proves that the agitation of the Macedonian leaders is largely responsible for the horrors which have undoubtedly occurred. He asserts that the supreme revolutionary committee at Sofia deliberately sent bands into Macedonia to provoke atrocities, on the strength of which they could appeal to the powers. These provocations were only too successful. The bands deliberately murdered a number of Turks in the Razlog district for the purpose of drawing vengeance. This followed as a matter of course, and the Turks lured the district, indulging in cruelty, lust and avarice.

France Distrusts Turkey.
 Paris, Feb. 10.—The officials here are not disposed to accept the Porte's assurance that Turkey has no intention of mobilizing a large force of troops. While the Porte denies such a move, the attention of the officials here who have access to the Government's sources of information the following reply was made:

"We have received similar pacific assurances from Turkish sources, but our own information is positive and specific that orders for the mobilization of troops have been actually issued. This was three days ago, and we are unable to say whether the execution of the orders is withheld in view of the effect they would produce among the powers who are seeking to enforce reforms in the Balkans. Our advisers further state that the mobilization would affect 240,000 troops."

The French Government's policy appears to be shaping on its own advice, without reference to the quieting Turkish assurances.

GERMANY SATISFIED.
