PAST. I WENT.

Singular. Akeetchkinclum, akeetchquinclum, akeetchclum.

Plural. A-keetchclum, akeetchkipclum, akeitchclum.

Future- I will go. Hoekin-nas

I don't want to go. Tah tah-ah kins nas mammon.

I may go. Ahs nasawhon-clo.

I am about to go. A-naskin-hah:

Go thou. Naswhamal-clo Go ye. Nasózeamal-clo.

Let us all go. Hoictamal-clo-nas.

We are going. Nyit. Gone. Nasclum.
