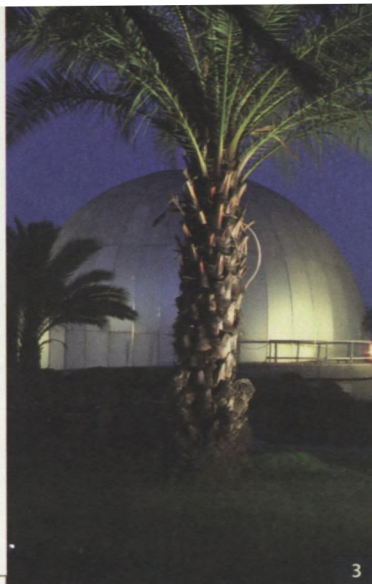

2005 also marked the signing of the Canadian Space Agency-Israeli Space Agency Memorandum of Understanding for Space Cooperation, reinforcing science and technology as one of the most important sectors for cooperation between the two countries.

In 2008, a Declaration of Intent to enhance cooperation in the area of public safety was signed. This declaration focuses on organized crime, emergency management

and crime prevention, and it aims to establish a more structured framework for the continuation of information sharing on public safety issues between Canada and Israel.

These are only a sample of the many formal bilateral instruments shared between Israel and Canada.
