

ARTICLE 30

Termination

1. This Convention shall continue in effect indefinitely but either Contracting State may, on or before June 30 of any calendar year beginning after the fifth year from the date of the entry into force of the Convention, give to the other Contracting State a notice of termination in writing through diplomatic channels. In such event, the Convention shall cease to have effect:

- (a) in respect of tax withheld at the source on amounts paid or credited to non-residents, after the end of that calendar year, and
- (b) in respect of other taxes, for taxation years beginning after the end of that calendar year.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned, duly authorized to that effect, have signed this Convention.

DONE in duplicate at Yerevan, on this 29th day of June 2004, in the English, French and Armenian languages, each version being equally authentic.
