

LAWRENCE AUSTIN HAYNE SMITH

Mr. Smith was born in Vizagapatam, India on October 30, 1929. He was educated at McMaster University where he obtained his B.A. and at Balliol College, Oxford where he was awarded his M.A. and B.Litt. He also studied and taught at the University of Toronto.

Mr. Smith joined the Department of External Affairs in 1957 and served at the Canadian diplomatic mission in Karachi from 1958 to 1961. From 1964 to 1968 he served with the Canadian Delegation to the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development in Paris. Upon his return to Ottawa in 1968, Mr. Smith assumed his present position as Director of the Aid and Development Division. Since 1972, Mr. Smith has been concurrently Deputy Director General of the Bureau of Economic and Scientific Affairs.
