## DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENT

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announces the following diplomatic appointment:

Mr. Daniel Molgat (51), born in Sainte-Rose du Lac, Manitoba, as Head of Mission and Ambassador to the European Communities in Brussels, Belgium.

Mr. Molgat [B.Comm, University of Manitoba, 1955; M.A. Oxford University, 1957 (Rhodes Scholar); Diploma, Institute of Political Studies, Paris, 1959] joined the Department of External Affairs in 1959. Between 1961 and 1972, he served abroad in Hong Kong, Islamabad and Washington. In 1972, he was Director, East Asia, and, in 1975, Director, Western Europe. Mr. Molgat was Ambassador to Portugal from 1977 to 1980. He served as Deputy Under-Secretary, Management, from 1980 to 1982; Assistant Deputy Minister, Management and Programs, from 1982 to 1983; and, from 1983 to 1985, Assistant Deputy Minister, Europe. Since 1985, Mr. Molgat has been Ambassador to Spain.
