That the Report of the Special Committee appointed to consider with Mr. Speaker the Procedure of this House, presented Monday, July 25, 1960, be concurred in.—The Minister of Trade and Commerce.

Mr. Fleming (Eglinton), a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, delivered a Message from His Excellency the Administrator of the Government of Canada, which was read by Mr. Speaker, as follows:

The Administrator transmits to the House of Commons Further Supplementary Estimates (3) of sums required for the service of Canada for the year ending on the 31st March, 1961, and, in accordance with the provisions of the British North America Act, 1867, the Administrator recommends these Estimates to the House of Commons.
