My dear Mr. Cohen:-

Since receiving your letter of January 13th I have ascertained the attitude of the Principal of Trafalgar Institute and of some members of the Board. I think it only fair to you to say that the Principal has decided to refuse all applications from Jewish children. I may add that the matter has not yet come before a meeting of the Board, but I know that after what I have told you, you will not consider for a moment asking that your daughter be admitted to an institution where there is any question of the welcome extended to Jewish children.

I am answering frankly as you asked me to do and I know you will treat my letter as confidential.
