Poultry E xtract from Annual Report 1930-31 "The year just completed has continued to show marked progress in the general activities of the Department and especially in research and experimental work under way. In spite of an outbreak of infectious bronchitis, which was followed by chicken pox during the mid-winter season, both of which affected the egg production of the poultry flock, the breeding season was one of the best experienced by the Department. The resulting flock of young stock came through in excellent condition, providing a splendid basis for the new year's work." Next year no mention of any disease in the flock.
