### ACT OF INCORPORATION.

ANNO REGNI SECUNDO GULIELMI IV.  
HIS EXCELLENCY MATTHEW LORD AYLMER, K.C.B.,  
*GOVERNOR IN CHIEF.*

“AT the Provincial Parliament, begun and holden at Quebec,  
“the twenty-fourth day of January, *anno domini*, one thousand  
“eight hundred and thirty-one, in the first year of the reign of  
“our Sovereign Lord William the Fourth, by the Grace of God,  
“of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland King,  
“Defender of the Faith, and from thence continued by several  
“prorogations to the fifteenth day of November, one thousand  
“eight hundred and thirty-one.

“Being the second session of the fourteenth Provincial Parlia-  
“ment of Lower Canada.”

#### CHAPTER 65.

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE MEMBERS OF THE NATURAL  
HISTORY SOCIETY OF MONTREAL.

25th February, 1832.—Presented for His Majesty's assent, and  
“reserved for the signification of His Majesty's pleasure  
“thereon.”

12th October, 1832.—Assented to by His Majesty in His Council.

8th January, 1833.—The Royal assent signified by the Procla-  
mation of His Excellency the Governor in Chief.
