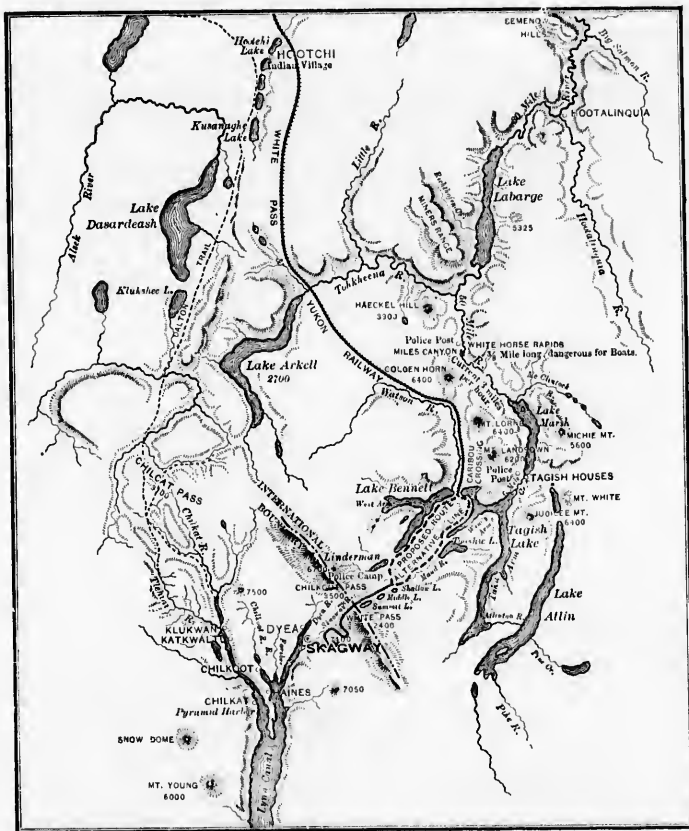


THE ROAD TO THE GOLD FIELDS.
